- First Class Challenge Area is also open for older scouts interested in working with troop assistant scoutmasters to complete rank requirements.

- Program blocks vary depending on class schedule and MB requirements. Some activities are not held at the same time each day or may take up 2 blocks during the day. Classes are held Monday through Thursday with merit badge make-up scheduled on Friday morning. Program blocks are 9:00-10:10 am, 10:30-11:40 am, 1:30-2:40 pm, 3:00-4:10 pm and 7:30-8:30 pm.
- See Leader Guide for details if you wish to plan your individual schedule.
- Scouts have the opportunity to earn 2-5 MBs depending on the level of difficulty and class schedule.
- Scouts are accepted on a first come, first serve basis. The troop will try to obtain the scout's choices based on selected prioritization.
- Open Program Areas are scheduled 4:15-5:00 pm Monday – Thursday and 9:00-11:30am Friday.
- The camp has time set aside for troop activities on Friday afternoon. Available options include: Gregg Boundary Trail 12 Mile Hike, Whitewater Rafting (additional charge), Campwide Activities.
